Environment Committee Chair Wally Sayko discussed the upcoming July 20 second stage re-vegetation activity and along with Bruce Johnson thanked those who participated in the first stage and encouraged all to participate.

President Al Potter introduced Mr. Justin Nawrocki who replaces Brett Hartis as the NCSU Extension Agent for Lake Gaston's aquatic vegetation program. Mr. Nawrocki gave a brief outline of his past education and work experience . He also discussed the hydrilla reduction program at the lake and outlined an experimental plan to address the threat that Lyngbya presents at Lake Gaston. Education Committee Chair Jeff Dowhan along with Mozine Lowe reviewed the upcoming Lakeside Learning event, which is planned for July 2nd at Edwards Beach.
