

March 4, 2015 LGA Monthly Meeting Minutes (Approved) **Lake Gaston Baptist Church, Hwy 903, Littleton, North Carolina**

President Al Potter conducted the welcome, Pledge of Allegiance, moment of silence and visitor/ membership introductions. Turnout was excellent with press coverage.

President Al Potter introduced the featured speaker Paul Smith, owner/operator of Frontline Defense Firearms Training Center and Range located south of Warrenton and Zebulon, N.C. Mr. Smith outlined the various services that are provided at his facility, including the proper handling and operating of a firearm. A course allowing for an application to a local sheriff's office for a conceal carry permit is offered, along with defensive firearm training. A membership dues schedule was made available. Non members can use some of the facility, at an hourly rate, on weekends. There were a number of questions from the members.

Secretary Tony Moran asked for and received a motion to approve the February monthly meeting minutes.

Treasurer Jack Saunders presented the treasurer's report which was accepted by the directors. He also stated that the home detector discount program was less than successful due to poor weather conditions.

Marketing and Membership Chair Bill Heflin reported up to date membership figures and restated the 2015 goal of 2500 members.

A member was concerned about getting a notification that her property was recertified as being in a flood zone. Membership suggested that she work with other nearby property owners, her board of supervisors and if needed, apply for a FEMA amendment. It was also pointed out that a change in a flood zone rating would be forwarded to her mortgage company.

President Al Potter advised and briefly discussed LGA upcoming events.

As there were no further issues raised, a motion to adjourn was made and approved.
