Presentation about use of solar at residence, savings, efficiency, bi-directional meter (to feed excess to grid), roof installation versus ground installation (pros/cons, issues with animals, roof repair), need for special invertor and array size to meet needs of home. Works from 9 AM to 3 PM if sun is shining, due to sun position. Doesn't work if rain, snow, clouds. Batteries are the most expensive component. Life cycle is 4-5000 cycles. (6-7 years life span) Panels can be purchased or leased.
